


## TOGETHER NOW



June 1st — July 31st at all Clark County Public Library Locations

For the children's program, ages birth to 12, children or their parent/caregiver will need to email their entries each week to: childrenssummerreading@ccplohio.org OR drop off entry at preferred library location. DO NOT DO BOTH. Please include child's name, age, phone number, email, school, preferred library location (same each week), how they heard about the program and number of hours read/read to/listened to each week. (Materials should be at appropriate reading level.)



Teens, age 13-18 (still in high school), should drop off their entries at any location or email them to: teensummerreading@ccplohio.org Please include their name, age, phone number, email, school, preferred library location (same each Week), how they heard about the program and title (s) of book(s) read in their entirety each week. (Materials should be at appropriate reading level for their age.)

Younger children (ages 11-12) can be in teen program with parental consent.

## **GRAND PRIZES**

A weekly drawing (each age group) for a \$15 gift card will be held at each location. At least 1 hour/1 book must have been read to qualify. Three larger prize baskets (each age group) will be given at the end of SRP at each location for reading 3 hours or more (1 book for teens). A grand prize (each age group) will be drawn from all for every 5 hours read (2 books for teens).

All entries must be turned in by July 31st. Entrants need not be present to win. If you are a weekly prize drawing winner, you have 10 days from when you are notified to collect your prize. Prizes not picked up in this time will be awarded to a runner up. Note: Library employees and their immediate families/members of their households are not eligible to win.
